Designed by David Ritch and Mark Saffel of 5d Studio, Bing brings a relaxed elegance to modern spaces in both the home and office. An object lesson in the resolution of beauty and utility, Bing's receptive shape attracts the eye, while the interior form looks and feels generous and welcoming. The chair's perimeter lies open, obscuring the line between seat and arm, thus encouraging casual postures and shifts of position. Resting on beautifully crafted stainless steel bases, either 4-star or tubular, the Luxe Lounge series offers three styles, including a non-traditional Wing Back. A coordinating Ottoman adds an extra level of comfort.

Preserving the approachable character of the Luxe Lounge pieces, the Mid- and High-Back Work Lounge chairs are scaled down for tight spaces and high-density interiors. Equipped with additional features like a 5-star, caster base and optional tablet arm, they make an attractive destination for work. Completing this versatile collection is a compact Guest Chair, which brings the warmth of wood to the mix of base materials, and complementary Occasional Tables with wood, stone or solid surface tops.
